



Governor Carina Van Cauter

Tasks and powers

The Governor is situated at the meeting point of different administrative approaches: bottom up and top down. She represents the federal and Flemish government in East Flanders. This means that the Governor is a mediator and bridge-builder between the various authorities in the province: the federal government, the Flemish government, the provincial administration and local authorities.

Flemish tasks

As the Flemish Government Commissioner, the governor oversees the correct operation of the local authorities. She deals with all complaints from citizens about these authorities. The Flemish Government also assigns tasks to the Governor for the strategic development of the province.

Federal tasks

As the Federal Government Commissioner, the Governor is also jointly responsible for overall safety in East Flanders. The fire service, police and firearms permits are her main tasks. She is also a member of the provincial safety consultative committee. In the event of serious disasters, she coordinates the emergency response. In addition, she has roles representing the province and established by protocol. For example, she accompanies the royal family when they visit the province.

International affairs

The Governor is jointly responsible for cross-border cooperation on behalf of the Province of East Flanders. She hosts international dignitaries, such as foreign governors and ambassadors, to implement international relations and put the province on the (world) map. Moreover, the Governor is also involved in international cooperation agreements.

Provincial tasks

The Governor chairs the East Flanders Deputation, without a voting right. She attends the meetings of the Provincial Council.
